



Notice to Elected Officials and Community Leaders: Texas GLO Housing Programs Update

GLO Homeowner Assistance Program (HAP) and Homeowner Reimbursement Program (HRP) applications to close by December 31st, 2019.

Due to the success of the Texas General Land Office's HAP and HRP programs to help Texans recover from Hurricane Harvey, both programs are reaching the end of their application window and will soon close.

Both programs are scheduled to close applications by December 31st, 2019 in order to focus on processing submitted applications to get recovery dollars out the door to help Texans.

The GLO encourages applicants to complete and submit their applications before the end of the year.

The GLO Homeowner Assistance Program has approved over 1,700 applications for construction with 640 homes currently under construction and 286 homes completed across 48 eligible counties. In some counties, applications surpass the amount of funding available and the HAP program will wait list applications in anticipation of additional federal funding to supplement the program. Potential applicants across all 48 Harvey-impacted counties are encouraged to apply before the December 31st, 2019 deadline.

The **Homeowner Assistance Program Regional Offices will remain open to take applications until 5:00pm on December 31st, 2019**. Potential applicants are welcome to complete applications online at <https://recovery.texas.gov/hap/>, or in-person at a regional office.

The GLO Homeowner Reimbursement Program is the first disaster recovery reimbursement program implemented in the State of Texas. The program reimburses Texas homeowners up to \$50,000 for out-of-pocket expenses for eligible repairs. So far, the HRP program has received over 6,000 completed applications and helped 776 applicants get approved for more than \$24 million. Potential applicants across all 48 Harvey-impacted counties are encouraged to apply before the December 31st, 2019 deadline.

The Homeowner Reimbursement Program will continue to take applications until 5:00pm December 31st, 2019, at <https://recovery.texas.gov/hrp/>.
