Sunday, February 21, 2010, at about 2:00 PM, Dickinson Police Department received a report of an attempted abduction.

A nine year old child reported while walking to a friend's home in the 2100 block of Avenue F an unknown white male came up behind her and told her to "come here". The child told the man she did not know him and ran to her house. The suspect reportedly followed the child, but was unable to keep up with her. The child told her mother who immediately drove the area checking for the suspect and then called police. Patrol officers checked the neighborhood, and spoke with neighbors in the area. No one reported seeing anyone matching the suspect's description.

The suspect is described as an older white male (possibly in his 50's), medium build, approximately 5'6" tall. The suspect had gray or white hair and a gray mustache. He was wearing a black baseball cap with a white baseball and red initials on it. He wore a black hooded jacket, blackish pants and black tennis type shoes.

The suspect was last seen on foot, there is no vehicle information.
