Possible Attempted Abduction of Child

On June 7, 2006, the Dickinson Police Department received a call of a possible attempted abduction of a five year old female in the 3300 block of Hughes Road. The possible attempted abduction occurred between 6:30 – 6:45 PM. Patrol officers arrived and determined the suspect(s) and suspect vehicle had already left the area. The five year old child was accompanied by an eight year old friend. The children were playing near the road when an unknown male approached in a vehicle. The vehicle is described as a brown four door vehicle. One child reported the vehicle was occupied by two black males and two Hispanic males. The second child reported the vehicle to be occupied by two black males and one Hispanic male. One of the black males is reported to have been grabbed the arm of the five year old through the window of the vehicle. The girls screamed and got the attention of another 11 year old friend who then yelled. The male subject let go of the five year old and the vehicle left the area.

Detectives have been following up with neighbors in the area to attempt to locate anyone else that may have seen or heard anything related to this possible attempted abduction. Detectives have not been able to develop any definite suspects or suspect vehicle.

The Dickinson Police Department is asking parents to be vigilant about watching their children and knowing where their children are and who they are with. Anyone with information is asked to call the Dickinson Police Department at 281-337-4700.
