On 10-09-2006 at approximately 12:25 P.M. officers from Dickinson Police Department were called to the 3500 block of Ohio in reference to a 2 year old child that was attacked by a dog. When the first officer arrived he located a dog on the front porch of the residence. When the officer exited the unit, the dog charged towards the officer. As the dog approached, the officer discharged his service weapon striking the dog one time causing it to run under the trailer.

Officers were able to enter the trailer and provide aid to the injured child. A few minutes later EMS personnel arrived and treated the female child. EMS called for life flight due to the extent of the injuries and the child was transported a short time later to Hermann Hospital.

As of the time of this press release, the child was still in surgery as a result of several large lacerations and punctures wounds.
