Dickinson Police are still actively searching for Earrand Leroy Peoples on a warrant charging him with murder in the death of Lorenzo Holder.

Shortly after noon on October 28, 2006, police received information that Peoples was hiding in an apartment in a complex in the 2600 block of 24<sup>th</sup> Street. Due to the violent nature of the crime as well as Peoples violent criminal record the Dickinson Police called for assistance from the Combined Agency Response Team (CART).

This team is a SWAT Unit consisting of officers from League City Police Department, Alvin Police Department, Alvin ISD Police Department and Pearland Police Department.

Police cordoned off the area for a little over four hours. The tenants in the complex were safely evacuated and CART moved in to check several vacant apartments. Peoples was not located.

Police are asking anyone with information of the whereabouts of Peoples to call the Dickinson Police Department at 281-337-4700, or their local police department. Peoples should be considered armed and dangerous.
