PRESS RELEASE

The Dickinson Police Department, along with the League City Police Department, is attempting to locate Earrand Peoples and Tiffany Monroe for their involvement in a recent crime spree.

On Friday October 27, 2006 at about 10:30 a.m. an aggravated robbery and kidnapping occurred in the 5600 block of West FM 646 in League City. The victim, a 24 year old League City man, was held up at gun point by Earrand Peoples and Tiffany Monroe. He was forced to drive the victim to Houston. The victim was released unharmed.

On Friday October 27, 2006 at about 3:45 p.m. Earrand Peoples got into a verbal argument with Lorenzo Holder, 33 years of age of Dickinson. They were in the 2600 block of 24th Street in Dickinson. Peoples pulled out a gun and shot Holder. Peoples fled the scene with his brother, Kenneth Peoples in a silver Honda. Holder later died of the gunshot wound. The Dickinson Police Department has charged Earrand Peoples with murder and a bond has been set at \$300,000.00.

On Saturday October 28, 2006 at about 1:00 p.m. we received information that Earrand Peoples was hiding in an apartment complex in the 2600 block of 24th Street. Due to the violent nature of the crime as well as Peoples violent criminal record the Dickinson Police called for assistance from the Combined Agency Response Team (CART). Police cordoned off the area for a little over four hours. The tenants in the complex were safely evacuated and CART moved in to check several vacant apartments. Peoples was not located.

On Monday October 30, 2006 at about 10:00 a.m., the League City Police Department was called to the 3000 block of League City Parkway regarding shots fired. When they arrived on location they found the silver Honda used by Kenneth Peoples to drive Earrand Peoples away from the Dickinson murder scene. The Combined Agency Response Team was called out and after a several hours Kenneth Peoples was arrested in the apartment complex. He was charged with being a felon in possession of a firearm. Neither Earrand Peoples nor Tiffany Monroe was located.

On Tuesday October 31, 2006 at about 3:00 p.m., a 29 year old Alvin man had his 1998 Plymouth Voyager, Texas License 965KLH, stolen from the 900 block of W FM 517 in League City. The vehicle was taken by Tiffany Monroe. Earrand Peoples was with Monroe.

On Tuesday October 31, 2006 at about 4:00 p.m. a female wearing a backpack entered the Amegy Bank at 2401 Termini in Dickinson. She handed a note to the teller stating she had a bomb and demanded money. The teller handed over between \$1,500 and \$2,000. The female then walked out the rear entrance of the bank and fled in a waiting green minivan or SUV driven by an unknown suspect. Through investigation the suspect was identified as Tiffany Monroe. Monroe has been charged with robbery in this case with a bond of \$250,000.00.

Tiffany Monroe has previous convictions for robbery and drug dealing. In addition to the robbery warrant she is currently wanted by the Dickinson Police Department for delivery of a controlled substance. Earrand Peoples has previous convictions for assault (five counts), possession of controlled substance, criminal mischief, and evading or resisting arrest (four counts).

Police are asking anyone with information of the whereabouts of Peoples or Monroe to call the Dickinson Police Department at 281-337-4700, or their local police department. They should be considered armed and dangerous.

A 6:00 p.m. live press conference will be held at the Dickinson Police Department located at 4000 Liggio, Dickinson, Texas on 11-03-2006.
