On 11/05/2010 the Dickinson Police Narcotic Unit with assistance from DEA and DPS Narcotics executed a search warrant at an apartment in the 3300 block of Hughes Lane, Dickinson.

Officers recovered almost two ounces of Cocaine and just over three pounds of Marijuana, along with scales and packaging material.

Robert Anthony Herrera, 22 years old, from Dickinson was charged with Possession of Cocaine with Intent to Deliver and Felony Possession of Marijuana. He received bonds totaling \$60,000.

That grade offense for the Cocaine is a First Degree Felony. An individual adjudged guilty of a felony of the first degree shall be punished by imprisonment in the institutional division for life or for any term of not more than 99 years or less than 5 years. In addition to imprisonment, an individual adjudged guilty of a felony of the first degree may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$10,000.

That grade offense for the Marijuana is a State Jail Felony. An individual adjudged guilty of a state jail felony shall be punished by confinement in a state jail for any term of not more than two years or less than 180 days. In addition to confinement, an individual adjudged guilty of a state jail felony may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$10,000.
