Aggravated Assault With A Deadly Weapon

On Thursday, November 10, 2005, at approximately 8:14am, officers were dispatched to the area of Oak Park and SH3 in reference to shots fired. A witness telephoned police and reported that a male on a bicycle fired a gun near McAdams Junior High School and that the male was traveling north on SH3. Officers located the male at Church Village Apartments located in the 2900 block of Deats Road which is fenced in. The male fled from officers and was not located.

Officers then learned from communications that a 13 year old male student from Dickinson was in the lobby complaining of an asthma attack. Dickinson Volunteer Fire Department responded. The student reported that someone attempted to shoot him.

Officers made contact with the student who reported that a person known as "Pie Face" followed behind him as he was walking to school. "Pie Face" was identified as 17 years of old Jermaine Small of Dickinson, Texas. The 13-year-old victim stated that Small had a confrontation with his family members in the past and the victim feared that Small might retaliate against him. As the victim walked to the Dickinson Police Department Small confronted the victim at the intersection of Oak Park and Liggio Street, which is approximately thirty feet from the Dickinson Police Station property and fifteen feet from McAdams Junior High School. Small displayed a handgun and told the victim to come with him. The victim ran and Small chased him. Small fired two shots at the victim as he was running toward the police station. The victim was not injured. Evidence was recovered from the scene.

The Dickinson Police station is used as a drop off and pickup site for Dickinson students attending the Dickinson Independent School District's Alternative Learning Center. Numerous students were standing in the police station's parking lot during the incident and no students or visitors were injured.

An arrest warrant was issued for Jermaine "Pie Face" Small for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon with a \$40,00.00 bond. Jermaine is not in custody at this time and any information to his whereabouts may be reported to the Dickinson Police Department at 281-337-4700
