Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon

November 13, 2007, at approximately 4:30 PM, officers were dispatched to the area of 39th Street and Colorado for a fight involving a large group of people. While in route, officers were further advised that a female had possibly been stabbed.

Officers arrived and located a twenty year old female victim with a stab wound to her left side. The victim was transported to UTMB ER by PHI Helicopter Ambulance.

Officers at the scene located two knives and several witnesses.

Detectives interviewed the witnesses and learned the victim and the suspect had on ongoing disagreement for some time. The victim and the suspect met up with each other in the 4700 block of 39th Street and confronted each other. The victim fought with a third person at the scene. After that fight had been broken up, the victim and the suspect turned their attention toward each other and exchanged words. The suspect pulled a knife and stabbed the victim, then fled the scene.

Detectives were able to identify the suspect as 26 year old Codi Machelle Easter. Detectives made contact with Easter by phone and met with her and two witnesses. Easter and the witness gave additional statements to detectives. Easter admitted to stabbing the victim.

Easter was arrested and charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and bond was set at \$15,000.00.

Aggravated assault with a deadly weapon is a 2nd degree felony, punishable by 2 to 20 years in prison and up to a \$10,000.00 fine.
