On Friday, November 25, 2005, at 10:30 AM, Dickinson Police Department Communications Division received a 911 call in reference to baby not breathing. Emergency personnel responded to the 4000 block of Briarglen and found a seven week old infant female not breathing. CPR was being performed by the parents and the child was transported to Mainland Medical Center in Texas City. Later that day the infant was transferred to UTMB Children's Hospital in Galveston and admitted to the Pediatric ICU. The infant had suffered fractured ribs, a fractured clavicle and a fractured skull.

The Dickinson Police Department is working together with CPS and medical staff to determine the cause of the injuries. The parents of the infant have been cooperating with the police department and the ongoing investigation. There are no charges pending in this case at this time.

The infant is currently in serious condition.
