On 12/07/2009 the Dickinson Police Narcotics Unit with assistance from the Galveston County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Unit and DPS Narcotics executed a search warrant at a residence in the 2500 Block of Ave. D, Dickinson.

Officers recovered 76.6 grams of Crack Cocaine, over 1 pound of Marijuana and 5 handguns.

Joseph Michael Spells, 28 years old, from Dickinson, was charged with Possession of Cocaine with Intent to Deliver and Felony Possession of Marijuana. His bonds total \$90,000.

The charge for the Cocaine is a First Degree Felony. An individual adjudged guilty of a felony of the first degree shall be punished by imprisonment in the institutional division for life or for any term of not more than 99 years or less than 5 years. In addition to imprisonment, an individual adjudged guilty of a felony of the first degree may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$10,000.

The charge for the Marijuana is a State Jail Felony. An individual adjudged guilty of a state jail felony shall be punished by confinement in a state jail for any term of not more than two years or less than 180 days. In addition to confinement, an individual adjudged guilty of a state jail felony may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$10,000.
